Listening in Mission..

This course will explore the practice and theology of listening in God's mission within local communities and how this may renew church imagination and impact in a rapidly changing society. Course attendees will explore mission approaches and be introduced to practices of local community research, theological reflection and discernment, in order to develop practical skills in mission attentiveness. Tools that enable group reflection, observation, and listening to local stories will be introduced so these skills can be deployed in church or mission teams.
